WOMEN'S WAY recently hosted our first virtual gathering "**Breaking Down Barriers: An Intimate Gathering To Ignite Change,**" to highlight the work of our organization and current initiatives. Hosted by Christine Lussier, who welcomed speakers Diane Cornman-Levy, Executive Director of **WOMEN'S WAY** and Nina Guzmán, Executive Director of **Alianzas de Phoenixville** to discuss our key programs to advance gender equity, our response to COVID-19, and its impact on immigrant women and their families in our region.
