## Lucretia Mott Honoree: Kathryn Kolbert, Esq.



Kathryn Kolbert has had a long and distinguished career advancing women's rights. As a public-interest attorney, journalist, executive in the non-profit world, she made her second appearance before the U.S. Supreme Court arguing the 1992 landmark case of *Planned Parenthood v. Casey*. *Casey* has been widely credited with saving *Roe v. Wade* until 2022 when both *Roe* and *Casey* were overruled by the Supreme Court in *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization*.

A co-founder of the Center for Reproductive Rights, Kolbert has been recognized by *The National Law Journal* as one of the "100 Most Influential Lawyers in America," and by *The American Lawyer* as one of 45 public-interest lawyers "whose vision and commitment are changing lives." She is the co-author with Julie F. Kay of *Controlling Women: What We Must Do Now to Save Reproductive Freedom*, which details nearly five decades of legal battles to save *Roe*, accurately predicted its demise, and proposes audacious new strategies for moving forward at this perilous time. Her Ted talk, "The End of *Roe* and What Comes Next for Reproductive Freedom" has received over 2 million views.

Kolbert's extensive activism and policy work includes many years of service in Philadelphia. She was a Staff Attorney with the Women's Law Project and Community Legal Services and developed and managed a program on law and American life at the University of Pennsylvania's Annenberg Public Policy Center. While at Penn she created and executive produced NPR's *Justice Talking*, an award-winning public radio program heard around the globe. A graduate of Temple University School of Law, Kolbert is a highly sought-after speaker at organizations throughout the country on women's and constitutional rights, activism, and leadership.
